

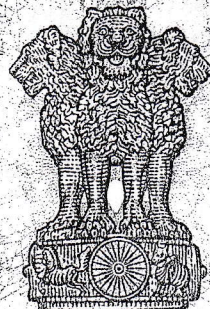

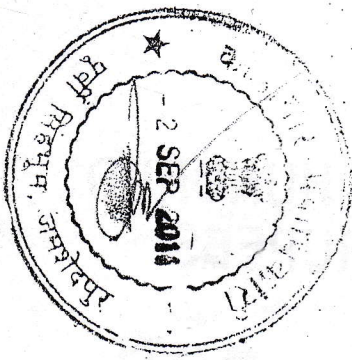

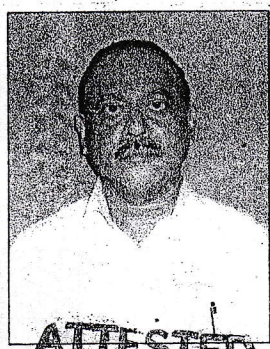

E. The above named first Trustees along with other co-opted with Trustees shall be trustees for life.

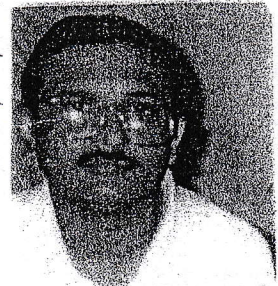

TOTAL NUMBER OF TRUSTEES

The total number of Trustees at any time shall not exceed 11 including managing Trustee and the Author/Settler shall remain Principal Trustee for ever, who alone is empowered to operate the account/s of the Trust or may authorize any Trustee for the purpose of operation of Bank account.

ADMINISTRATION

- 6) To promote the various field of entertainment like Telefilms, Video Films, advertisement films, and CDs through own production, distribution in various market channels.

The general management of the Trust of the purpose of managing the affairs and properties and carrying out the objects of the trust aforesaid shall be vested in the board of Trustee.

The Principal Trustee shall be the managing Trustee, who will discharge his duties with the Trust as first chairman of the Trust.

The first chairman shall be decided by the Trustees. The office of the chairman shall be for a period of 5(five) years.

Thereafter the existing Trustees and without prejudice may elect a new chairman in place of existing chairman to continue after passing a resolution.

But existing chairmen may continue as majority votes.

- I) To enter into contracts and borrow money from bank, institutions or individual for purpose of Trust and management of its properties and assets.
- II) To appoint officers and staff at such remuneration if any they think fit.
- III) To appoint consultants for specific purposes on such terms and conditions as they may deem fit.
- IV) To make rules and regulations from time to time for the management and conduct of the affairs of the Trust and its properties and assets.

#### POWER OF TRUSTEES

The Trustees will also have following powers:-

- i) To apply the whole or part of the income or accumulation thereof or whole or part of the corpus of the Trust Properties for one or more for the objectives of the Trust as the Trustees may from time to time determine.
- ii) To amalgamate the Trust with any other Trust or charity for wholly public charitable purpose.
- iii) To convert and get in the trust properties and / or to vary the investments for the time serving.

ix) To settle, comprise or compound, out of court, all suits action and other proceedings and to settle all differences and demands and to refer any or all such suits, action or other proceedings, difference or demand to arbitration and to adjust and settle all account.

x) To pay all costs, charges and expenses incidental to the management, administration and execution of the Trusts and power herein contained.

- xi) To purchase or hire or to take on lease lands, building and other immovable and movable properties in the name of the Trust.
- xii) To raise or borrow moneys required for the purpose of the Trust on mortgage or pledge of the Trust Estate or any part thereof with or without any security and at such rate of interest and on such terms & conditions as the Trustees shall think fit.
- xiii) To do such acts and things that may be incidental and necessary to attain the objectives of the Trust.

DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES

- i) The Trustees shall be chargeable only for, such moneys, stocks, shares and funds that shall actually come into their hands and shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default acts or commission or commission of the either Trustees or of any Bankers of other persons with whom the trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or handed over unless caused by their willful neglect or default.
- ii) All the Trustees shall be bound to maintain and defend all such suits, and (subject to the provision of this deed) to take such other steps as may be reasonably requisite for the preservation of the trust and the assertion or protection of the title.
- iii) The trustees shall be bound to deal with the trust property as carefully as a man of ordinary prudence to deal with which property if it were their own, and, in the absence of a contract to the contrary trustees so dealing shall not be responsible for the loss, destruction or deterioration of the trust property.
- iv) If Trustees shall be destructive or permanently injurious to the Trust property, the remaining Trustees shall be bound to take measures to prevent such act.
- v) The Trustees shall be bound to keep clear and accurate accounts of the Trust property.

RIGHTS OF THE TRUSTEES

- i) The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration as Trustees by any reimburse themselves of all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with Trust or their duties relating thereto. If any Trustees empowered by the Board of Trustees to act as full time trustee to achieve the object of the Trust may entitled to get a suitable maintenance remuneration with the consent of other Co- Trustees after passing a resolution of such effect in the meeting of Board of Trustees.
- ii) The Trustees may from time to time associate with the activities of Trust any person or persons of public eminence as patron or patron in chief and may appoint or make provision for appointment of committee or sub-committees for conduct of the affairs of the Trust for the purpose of administration of any Project undertaken by the Trust in consonance with the object of the Trust. Appointment of the committee members shall be done by the Board of Trustees. However the Managing Trustees of the committee so appointed by the members of the direct control and supervision of Board of Trustees.
- iii) The Trustees may from time to time, frame scheme, rules & regulations, laws and bye laws for regulating the affairs of the projects undertaken by the Trust in pursuance to the various objects . Such rules as framed by the Board of Trustees for the contract of affairs of the project shall be binding and no deviation shall be permissible in any of the rules so framed by any authority whatsoever connected with the said project without the prior approval of the Board of Trustees.
- iv) The Trustees shall have an advisory committee of national level to advise the Trustees on the activities of the Trust and to suggest how to make them better serve its aims and objects. The strength of the Advisory Committee shall not exceed 50 (fifty) at a given time . The members of the advisory committee shall share the Trust in honorary capacity but they may be

reimbursed such expenses as may be incurred by them for attending the meeting of the Advisory Committee, if so decided by the Trustees.

IDENTITY OF TRUSTEES ETC.

iii) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees and evidence in writing under the hands of three - fourth of the Trustees or the number nearest thereof shall be as valid and effectual as resolution duly passed at the meeting of the Trustees.

iii) The existing Trustees may appoint one or more, Trustees at their discretion from time to time, but in any case. The total number of the Trustees including the new trustee to be appointed shall not exceed twenty five. Upon appointment of new Trustees jointly with the continuing or surviving Trustees power and subject to this Trust.

- iii) The Trustees may if they consider necessary in the interest of the Trust to add, to delete or amend this declaration of Trust and on such additional deletion or variation of terms contained in the deed by resolution of Trustees unanimously the terms of this declaration shall be deemed to contain the terms with such amendments, deletion or variation or in case of opinion arising amongst the Trustees and in all matters where the Trustees shall have the discretionary power the opinion of the majority of the Trustees present except as provided in various foregoing clauses, shall prevail and be binding on the majority as well as those Trustees who may not have noted and if the Trustees are equally divided the matter shall be decided according to casting vote of the Managing Trustee/Chairman.
